SWIFT EDUCATIONAL CONTINUITY IN THE WAKE OF HURRICANE IAN

THE CHALLENGE

In the aftermath of Hurricane Ian in 2022, Lee County was left with a significant challenge. The storm had severely damaged the local school infrastructure, making many buildings uninhabitable. With the school year already underway, the county faced the urgent task of finding a way to continue education for countless students without delay.

THE SOLUTION

Cotton Logistics partnered with Mobile Modular to quickly set up a temporary educational campus for displaced students. They deployed 73 modules, creating over 38,000 square feet of classroom and office space, using in-fleet assets. Despite time constraints, both teams worked tirelessly, even through Thanksgiving, to finish by early December 2022. This project's success demonstrated modular construction's effectiveness in emergencies, ensuring uninterrupted education in Lee County.
